Sutter-Meyer Farmhouse Is Getting a Butterfly Garden!

Fifteen volunteers from the University City Citizens Volunteer Corps (CVC) converged at the Farmhouse in early November 2015 to prepare the soil for our Monarch Butterfly Waystation Garden (see picture).

Local resident and landscape designer Linda Wiggen Kraft of Creveling Gardens designed the garden area. The volunteers—all U. City residents—spent 3 hours outlining the garden, putting down flattened cardboard and newspapers, and covering it all with a good layer of mulch (a planting technique known as the "lasagna method").

The "lasagna" will cook over the winter. Come spring, the area will be ready for planting. Linda Kraft and Linda Fried will pick out the appropriate plants, and then the volunteers will be back to plant them.

We are very excited about this project—and look forward to seeing the butterflies, bees, and other pollinators that will join us at the farmhouse next summer.
